Interchange wins the tender for a new Bureau de Change at Warsaw Chopin Airport.

Interchange in Poland announces today that it has won a tender to operate a new Bureau de Change in Terminal A at the Warsaw Chopin Airport. This brings the number of Interchange cash exchange offices operating in Poland to 28, 9 of which are in airports (Warsaw, Gdansk, Wroclaw and Katowice)

Talking about this new opening, Lionel Coron, the Managing Director of Interchange Group in Poland said:

“This is a welcome boost to our already strong presence in the Polish airports and throughout Central Europe, and winning this tender is a testament to all of our hard work over the past years.”

Interchange has been operating cash exchange offices in Poland since 2006, opening its first bureau the same year. Since then, it has expanded rapidly throughout the country and it is now one of the biggest foreign exchange operators in Central Europe. The company is also steadily increasing the number of airports in which it operates: in Central Europe alone, it holds airport concessions in five different capital cities - Budapest, Vienna, Prague, Warsaw and Bratislava - as well as the important regional airports of Poland.”
